The AAPL Quarterly Board Meeting was supposed to be held in Acme, Michigan but due to restrictions from Covid-19 AAPL decided to hold the Board Meeting virtually. AAPL By The Numbers

- 11,489 AAPL members (as of 8/24/20 compared to 14,254 same time last year)
- 4,868 CPL's, RPL's, and RL's (as of 8/24/20 compared to 5,181 same time last year)

Education

- <u>GOOD NEWS!</u> AAPL/TAPL will have the CPL/RPL Exam in Tulsa on Friday, November 13, 2020 Due to Covid-19, the review will not be part of the exam exam only. Sign up today!
- Recertification Extensions:
 - RL's Certification Committee authorized a 90-day extension with certification expiration dates of 3/31/20 – 12/31/20 to earn required recertification credits.
 - RPL's & CPL's there is already a 90 day "grace period" to meet recertification requirements; however, the Certification Committee has authorized a 90 day extension (total 180 days) with certification dates of 3/31/20 – 12/31/20 to meet recertification requirements.

Financials

As the negative impacts continue from Covid-19, AAPL believes we will experience a significant downturn that may last up to two years. In fact, AAPL is anticipating a loss between \$1.4 and \$4 million for this fiscal year. Fortunately, saving and investing over many years have allowed us to weather these difficult times. No plans to cut any benefits to the members. The following are accounts associated with the AAPL and the dollar amounts as of 6/30/20:

- Total Assets = \$38,682,950 (down from \$40,110,013 as of 6/30/19)
- AAPL, Inc's Investment Accounts = \$30,999,467 (up from \$30,044,461 as of 6/30/19)
- AAPL Educational Foundation, Inc. = \$4,331,244 (down from \$4,394,565 as of 6/30/19)
- Landman Scholarship Trust = \$7,770,990 (down from \$7,811,987 as of 6/30/19)
 - o Landman Scholarship Trust gave out 39 scholarships last fiscal year totally \$196,000.

- CONTRACT CENTER: **Keep an eye out for this!** More and more documents/contracts are being made available through the AAPL website and downloadable from Contract Center. A second round of forms has been approved and funded for preparation NPRI Ratification and Pooling. Production Sharing Agreements, Participation Agreements, and Purchase and Sale Agreements are in the works! *Membership has its benefits!*
- Contract Center's price has been decreased to \$250 per year (originally \$375) for members.
- <u>Professional Development Assistance</u>: Did you know? AAPL will provide up to \$300 per educational event, twice a year per member in reimbursement. There is no "need" base requirement for the reimbursement and any active member in good standing can apply.
- Need Ethics Credits? AAPL has the new Ethics videos online. There are 16 new videos with a low cost of \$25 per video.
