OCAPL's Nomination to AAPL for the 2019 Special Awards (Community Service)
Jordan McGee, CPL, Chairman OCAPL's Community Affairs



The members of OCAPL take Community Service very seriously and are very proud of the programs that we have put together over the years to serve those we live and work with in our community. Our Community Affairs Committee works hard each year to host a variety of events that appeal to our membership and encourage participation. Jordan McGee has been instrumental in cultivating and implementing new projects as Chairman of the Community Affairs Committee. We appreciate the opportunity to share with you some of our highlights and successes under Jordan's leadership in 2019.

Our members spent 38 Hours volunteering at The Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma performing various tasks such as sorting food donations, moving /organizing pallets and packing various lunch items to be distributed to the hungry. The food bank has provided food to families since 1981 and feed over 136,000 Hungry Oklahoman's each week. In 2018, The Food Bank was able to distribute over 49.7 million pounds of food throughout 53 Counties and project to exceed those numbers in 2019.

Jordan also helped OCAPL raised over \$42,000 through member events that went directly to support local non-profit organizations: Pivot and Good Shepherd Ministries. Pivot is a nonprofit community organization that advocates, educated, intervenes and counsel's youth and families to make a positive difference in their lives. Good Shepherd Ministries, which is a local nonprofit organization focuses on providing consistent, quality medical and dental services for hundreds of uninsured and underserved Oklahomans. This is an incredible assistance to those in need considering the average cost of health care insurance in the State of Oklahoma is \$787 per month.
