Ronald K. “Ron” Munn, CPL/ESA

Ronald K. “Ron” Munn, CPL/ESA, is the General Manager of Chevron North American Exploration and Production Company’s (CNAEP) Land Department. He provides guidance to the commercial land activities including acquisition, exploration, development, production, maintenance and divestiture on over 20 MM gross acres across the continental U.S., Gulf of Mexico, and Canada. Ron also establishes business plans and puts in motion the strategic framework and direction for an organization of 200+ Land employees. He is forward thinking and has been instrumental in advancing digital technology within Chevron’s Land Department.

Ron maintains his certification as a Certified Professional Landman & Environmental Site Assessor with the American Association of Professional Landmen. Through his career he has been actively involved in AAPL and in local Professional Landman associations including: Permian Basin Landman’s Association (PBLA); Professional Landmen’s Association of New Orleans (PLANO) - where his was voted Landman of the Year in 2010, served as Treasurer and on the Scholarship committee; Bakersfield Association of Professional Landmen (BAPL) – where he co-chaired the West Coast Institute in 2012, 2013 and 2014; and Houston Association of Professional Landmen (HAPL). Currently Ron serves on the NAPE Operators Committee and in 2020 will serve as the Chair of the committee. In 2019 he was instrumental in securing CNAEP’s General Counsel for the inaugural NAPE Summit “Connections & Conversations”, VP of Drilling and Completions as the Luncheon Speaker at Summer NAPE, and CNAEP President as guest speaker at HAPL’s Executive night. Under Ron’s leadership, Chevron employee participation in AAPL has increased significantly with 113 currently active members of AAPL.

Ron graduated from the University of Texas in 1981 with a Bachelor of Business Administration in Petroleum Land Management. He was President of the Longhorn Band from 1980/1981. He began his career with Getty Oil Company in Midland, TX and has held roles of increasing responsibility as an individual contributor and as Chevron’s Land Manager for the San Joaquin Valley Business Unit in California, Land Manager for the Appalachian Mountain BU in PA and since July 2016, as the General Manager of the Land Department.

Ron is giving back to his Alma Mater and profession as an active member of the Executive Council for the McCombs Energy Initiative at the University of Texas and has also been tapped by the Texas Executive Education committee to serve as a McCombs Energy mentor.
